The Lewis Family Light Show: 12 Shenandoah Road, Warwick, RI



Christmas is a family affair for the Lewises. For the past 23 years, their home has become a glowing mecca of holiday cheer with a high-tech twist.

The Lewis Family Light Show is the only Christmas display in New England with an interactive mobile website that allows visitors to see which song will be playing next. Visitors can even change the playlist by voting for their favorite song! [Check out the site here.](#)

Like most of the displays on this list, the Lewis display takes a lot of time and effort to complete. The display typically takes more than 120 hours to set up and includes more than 100 extension cords to power all of the high-tech lights that “dance” in time to the music.

The display begins on Friday, Nov. 29, at 5 p.m. and runs through Dec. 31. (Sunday through Thursday from 5–8:55 p.m., and Friday and Saturday nights from 5–9:25 p.m.) You can listen to the show by tuning your car radio to 106.9 FM.

This year, the Lewis family will accept donations on behalf of The Autism Project and the Gloria Gemma Breast Cancer Resource Foundation. Last year, the Lewises raised \$2,630 for the Autism Project.
