The Lewis Family Light Show, 12 Shenandoah Road, Warwick, RI

Christmas is a family affair for the Lewises. For the past 20 years, their home has become a glowing mecca of holiday cheer, and this year, it's gone totally 21st century. The Lewis Family Light Show is the only Christmas display in new England with an interactive mobile website that allows visitors to see which song will be playing next. Like most of the displays on this list, the Lewis display takes a ton of time and effort to complete. This year's display took more than 120 hours to setup. It includes more than 100 extension cords to power all of the high-tech lights that "dance" in time to the music.

The display begins on Friday, Nov., 25 at 5 p.m. and runs through Dec. 31. The Lewises light the lights Monday through Thursday from 5 to 8:55 p.m., and Friday and Saturday nights from 5 to 9:55 p.m. You can listen to the 29 different Christmas songs by tuning your car radio to 106.9 FM.
